With the COVID-19 issues, we must consider moving from primarily face-to-face teaching to possible temporary online teaching. As we think about this, many are asking will our primary tools for teaching online, D2L Brightspace, Kaltura video and Bb Collaborate (video conferencing) services be robust enough for the rush to new online classes. These are all cloud services, built on an architecture that is intended to scale as needed.
